The day's competitions

In the morning session, The Royal Marsden Trophy competition will be played over 18 holes off full handicaps (BAGS handicaps for BAGS Members and Club/Society handicaps for Guests). The BEST THREE Stableford points scored **at each hole** will be added together to make the team total over 18 holes. There is also a competition for the best individual score over 18 holes.

In the afternoon, the field will divide into three groups for two separate nine hole Texas Scramble competitions off the 1st, 7th and 11th tees respectively.

TEXAS SCRAMBLE RULES

All players drive off and one of the tee shots is selected. All players, **excluding the person whose drive was chosen**, then play from that position - **placing anywhere on the course within six inches, no nearer the hole**. This procedure is repeated until the hole is completed. The team score will be the total shots for the nine holes minus the team handicap shown on the card. **N.B. The team must use a minimum of two tee shots from each player.**

The Royal Marsden Wolfson Children's and Adolescent Unit is one of the largest children's cancer units in the UK, seeing more than 200 new young patients and their families every year.

However, in order to offer promising new treatments, it's vital that the dedicated team of researchers have access to the latest technological advances. Consequently, the Unit needs to raise £500,000 every year. So please give generously.

BAGS: snapshots

BAGS was founded in 1993 and held its first event in March of that year at the Wentworth East Course when 16 players took part. Though there were only five events in that season, these were so well supported that the number held each year quickly rose to nine, soon to include an annual event to raise money for Charity. In fact the Society proved so popular that the number of members had ultimately to be capped at 60 though guests are always assured of a warm welcome on our golf days for which the average turnout is 50.

This year's Charity event will be the 134th day fixture run by BAGS. This is in addition to 13 tours on which we have played many courses in England, Scotland, Ireland, Portugal and France. On special anniversaries we have visited Wentworth West (50th), Walton Heath (75th), Coombe Hill (100th) and Sunningdale (10th year), while in March of this year, we commemorated our 15th birthday by enjoying the unforgettable delights of St George's Hill.

We value the opportunity to play our golf on attractive courses in good company and are delighted to see so many old friends returning to today's event.

This year's Charity day will be the 14th fund raising event run by BAGS since it was formed.

The Society has been raising money for the Royal Marsden since 1995 when there was a Charity Matchplay event involving 32 players at Tyrrells Wood which raised £276! From such small beginnings, in the 13 charity matches since that date (now involving 112 players!) we've reached a total figure of just over £145,000 for this very worthwhile cause which is so close to all of us.

Apart from Betchworth Park, which today hosts its 10th Charity event, and Tyrrells Wood where we staged the Matchplay matches in 1995 and 1996, Copthorne and Farnham also played host in '97 and '98.
